Express Appointments

We are aware that there can, at times, be a delay in seeing your doctor and some things just can't wait. To address this we have instigated a system of one doctor each day setting aside some time for those acute problems. This is for a single problem only and may not be with your usual doctor. Ask our reception staff for more details.

Contacting Your GP

GP's in our practice may be contacted by phone during normal surgery hours. If the GP is attending to a patient, a message will be taken and the reception staff will advise when it is likely that the GP will return your call. Your call will always be put through to the GP in an emergency, if you are unsure ask to speak to a nurse.

Nursing Services

Both our nurses are trained to perform Pap Smears and Well Women's Checks. Both nurses are also Midwives and offer a range of services to new and expecting parents including breast feeding advice, overcoming mastitis, settling techniques, sleeping patterns, weight checks and immunisation. Our nurses also assist our doctors with health assessments and minor surgery as well as many other day to day duties.

Administration

Appointments

Appointments can be made by phoning the surgery on 40511074 or if you prefer you can use our online appointment request at <u>http://www.draperstreet.com.au</u>. Every effort will be made to accommodate your preferred time and GP.

Emergencies will always be given priority and our reception staff will attempt to contact you if there is any unforeseen delay or your GP has been called away.

A standard consultation is designed to accommodate a single or uncomplicated matter at a cost of \$65.00. Longer consultation times are available, so please let our receptionists know if you require some extra time.

If you or a family member, require and interpreter service, we can organize this for you also.

If you are unable to attend your appointment please call and cancel. A 'No Show' fee may be charged for those who do not attend their appointments on the day.

We also provide SMS appointment reminders that will be sent to your mobile phone at around 9am one business day before your appointment. Appointments can be cancelled or confirmed by return SMS, just follow the instructions. If you do not want to take advantage of this service please let the reception staff know.

Billing Arrangements

Fees are payable at the time of consultation by cash, cheque (by arrangement only), Mastercard, Visa or EFTPOS we do not accept American Express. Our fees and charges are displayed at the surgery for the more common items. If you have any difficulties in paying our fees, please feel free to

discuss it with us.

All our GPs will bulk bill children under 5 years of age and aged pensioners. For more information on our billing policies you can pick up our billing policy brochure from reception.

Results and Xrays

Please ring for your results after 2pm this gives the doctor a chance to receive and look over your results. The doctor will let you know how long you should wait before contacting us. Generally, blood tests take up to 2 days, pap smears and histology can take up to 7 days. Results may take longer at busier times.

We do not store Xrays here at the practice under any circumstance. After you have had your Xray please ring and make an appointment to discuss the Xrays with your doctor.

Privacy

In handling your medical records it is the practice policy to maintain utmost confidentiality and security at all times. Your information is only available to authorised members of the staff. We follow the National Privacy Principles set out at http://www.privacy.gov.au/health/index.html

Additional Services

Repeat Prescriptions / Referrals

Repeat prescriptions and repeat referrals may be available, subject to legal requirements and the doctors discretion. A fee of \$10 applies to each of these services. Whilst every effort is made to deal with requests promptly it may take up to 2 business days to complete your request. You can call the surgery for these services, or alternatively you can go to our website where there is an online form to request repeat prescriptions.

Home Visits

Home visits are available for regular patients of this practice whose condition prevents them from attending the surgery. If you feel you need a home visit please contact surgery staff to discuss the issue.

After Hours contacts

If you need medical assistance outside normal surgery hours there are a range of available options.

- For emergencies (such as chest pain or shortness of breath) contact 000 without delay
- The Cairns Base Hospital out patients clinic is open 24 hours a day (ph 4050 6333).
- We have an agreement with Cairns 24 Hour Medical Centre (Ph: 4052 1119) for continuing care of our patients when our surgery is closed (including home visits if necessary and appropriate). If you attend the Cairns 24 Hour Medical Centre please advise the receptionist and doctor you are a patient of this practice and ask that a copy of the consultation notes be forwarded to this surgery at the conclusion of your consultation. These notes will ensure continuity of care. Be aware that the Cairns 24 Hour has it's own billing policies, especially with regard to home visits.

Emergencies

All emergencies should be directed to the ambulance on 000.

Complaints

We hope you do not have any complaints about our surgery but if you are unsatisfied in any way direct your complaints first to the practice manager, James Lake.
